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We have come a long way in making sure students with disabilities enroll in college, but there is still much work to do. Students with learning disabilities enroll in four-year schools at half the rate as those in the general population, and fewer of them are graduating. While many students enter college unprepared for the demands of college-level work, students with learning disabilities can find that the increased demands, coupled with the lack of structure and support to which they may have been accustomed, can present additional challenges. It is important for families, educators, and involved professionals to know about the changes in disability services at the college level and what supports and skills can help students be successful.
